Use of Personal Mobile Devices

Use of Personal Mobile Devices in Schools

In response to the province of Alberta's ban on the use of personal mobile devices at school, we would like to remind parents of our École St. Paul School policy.

According to the provincial ban, student cell phones, tablets, laptops, and/or headphones must be stored in their backpacks (powered off or on silent mode) for the entire school day, including recess and lunch breaks. Smartwatches must have texting/ calling/ browsing features turned off during school hours or must remain in a backpack. This is consistent with our current practices at École St. Paul School and we are confident that students and families will continue to support this endeavour.

If students need to contact their parents, they may do so using the office phone or their classroom phone. Parents who need to contact their child can do so by phoning the office at 780-799-5760.

Students will continue to be provided with optimal learning opportunities that promote the use of appropriate technology usage with school devices.

If issues arise with a student's cell phone or smartwatch use, the student's device(s) will be kept securely in the office until the end of the school day. Parents will be notified and asked to work with us to make a plan moving forward.
